The St. Lucia Civil Association has elected a new National Executive Council at the Election held on Wednesday 25th April, 2018.

Mr. Cyprian Montrope emerged as President capturing 59% of the vote cast in a relatively low turnout of members who cast their votes yesterday. He defeated Rock Jean (22%) and Cletus Cyril (19%).

Ms. Josephine Farrell was elected as 1st Vice President capturing 62% of the votes cast. Her opponent Dan Stephen received 38% of the votes cast.

The other positions of the Executive Council were uncontested and the persons nominated for those posts were elected unopposed in accordance with Section 6.5 (h) of the CSA's Constitution.
